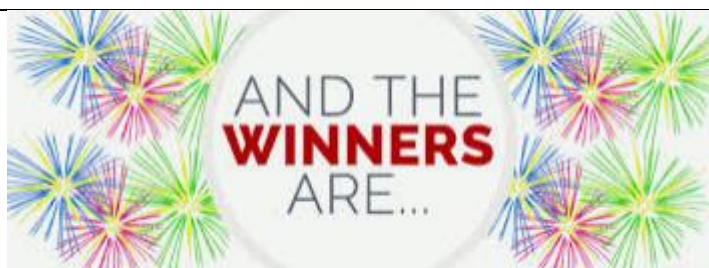


Howes Primary School Newsletter: 9th October 2020
